**Kling Adds Another Medal to the Trophy Case**  
***Philadelphia design firm earns AIA Silver Medal in Harrisburg***

PHILADELPHIA, PA – May 15, 2006 – A/E/I design firm Kling was recently presented with the Silver Medal at the American Institute of Architects (AIA) Pennsylvania Chapter's 2006 Design Awards ceremony for their design of the Buccini/Pollin Group and E.J. DeSeta Office and Manufacturing Building in Wilmington, DE.

The 94,000 SF building, which serves as the new home for real estate developer, The Buccini/Pollin Group, and E.J. DeSeta, a metal fabrication company, was also the 2005 recipient of AIA Philadelphia Chapter's seldom given Gold Medal award. The project has been featured in Architectural Record and The Philadelphia Inquirer.

Jury comments for the Buccini/Pollin and DeSeta Building noted that "the jury loved the incredible craftsmanship, and how it was enriched by the family story behind the building ... It has beautiful façade composition, a beautiful floor plan and great interiors. This project is worthy of national recognition."

In addition to winning silver in Harrisburg, Kling walked away with a Citation of Merit for their design of the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center (UCHSC) Research Complex I in Aurora, CO. It is worthy to note that the multi-storied, 622,000 SF facility also received an Award of Recognition at AIA Philadelphia Chapter's 2005 Design Award ceremony. According to the jury, "This building [was] beautifully executed ... there were several science and research projects submitted. This is the only one to receive an award."

"We were extremely fortunate to have worked with clients who were not only invested in contributing to the revitalization of the urban environment, but were also cognizant of and contributory to issues of artistry," states Bradford W. Fiske, AIA, Kling's Director of Design.
