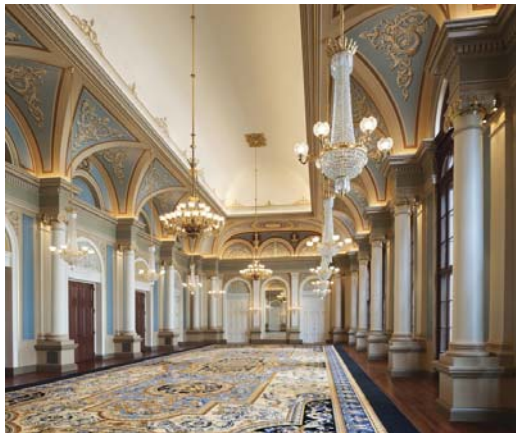

## KlingStubbins takes home two AIA Philadelphia Design Excellence Awards

### Academy of Music and Campbell Employee Center receive honors

PHILADELPHIA, PA – October 25, 2010 –KlingStubbins was the recipient of two Design Excellence Awards from American Institute of Architects Philadelphia Chapter at last week’s annual awards reception held at the Loews Philadelphia Hotel. The firm’s restoration of the Academy of Music Ballroom earned an Honor Award for Historic Preservation, while its design of the new Campbell Employee Center in Camden, New Jersey, was honored with a Merit Award.

Jury comments for the Academy of Music Ballroom stated, “The restoration of the Ballroom of the Academy of Music was an easy project to honor with an award. It is a

carefully done restoration and the colors have given the Ballroom new life and elegance.” KlingStubbins has now received four awards for its meticulous research and design of the Academy of Music Ballroom. The restoration of the National Historic Landmark was most recently recognized with a Citation of Merit from AIA Pennsylvania, as well as an Historic Interior Award from Preservation Pennsylvania and a Grand Jury Award from the Preservation Alliance for Greater Philadelphia. *Contract Magazine* featured the project in its September 2010 issue.

The AIA Philadelphia Merit Award is the first design accolade won by the Campbell Employee Center. The jury remarked, “The Campbell Employee Center is a handsome building. It is a professional, well-controlled design that gives a strong image to the Campbell Soup Company. The building seems to offer pleasant amenities to the Company’s employees.” In its ongoing efforts to represent innovation, progression, and a stimulation of local economic growth, the Campbell Soup Company constructed the cutting-edge, ecologically friendly 85,000-
